

# Snowline Recycling Center Rules

The recycling center is a locked facility and can be opened with your compactor key.

Recycle the following materials by placing them in the marked recycling totes.

## Mixed Paper Only

*Do not place in plastic bags*



Yes:

- Old mail, magazines, catalogs
- Envelopes, stationery, labels, cartons & bags
- Computer, fax, copy & note paper
- Shoe & cereal boxes (discard liners and flatten)

No:

- *Paper towels, plates, napkins or dirty or soiled papers*
- *Wax or plastic-coated papers (i.e. milk, juice or frozen food containers)*  
*Plastic, foiled paper, tissue paper or carbon paper*

## Newspaper Only

*Do not place in plastic bags*



Yes: Clean newsprint, inserts, ads

No: Plastic delivery bags or rubber bands

## Bottles & Cans Only

*Do not place in plastic bags*



Yes:

- Glass bottles & jars. All colors accepted. Discard lids. Rinse clean. Avoid breaking glass
- Aluminum cans, tin cans and foil products. Flatten all aluminum cans, tin cans and foil products. Remove labels from tin cans (recycle paper labels with mixed paper)

Plastic bottles with necks (ie. where bottle opening is smaller than base). **Tubs, Jars, Pails, Buc kets (up to one gallon) and single serve cup lids. Rinse all containers clean. Nest tubs together. Flatten plastic bottles. Remove and discard all bottle caps, rings, lids and pumps.** All colors and numbers accepted. Labels are OK.

- Milk, water, soda, juice, ketchup, cooking oil, detergents, etc.
- Shampoo, soap, cosmetic, medicine, contact lens solution, etc.
- Detergent, fabric softener, household cleaner, bleach, etc.
- Windshield washer fluid

No:

- *Window glass, windshields, light bulbs, mirrors, fluorescent tubes, ceramics or Pyrex*
- *Oil filters, air filters, aerosol cans*
- *Clamshells, bottle caps, rings, pumps, Styrofoam, foam rubber, plastic bags, toys or plastic containers that held hazardous materials*
- *Plastic lids, wrap, film, bags, tableware, pipe, extrusions, Styrofoam, foam rubber, insulation, plastic-coated papers, milk cartons, or juice boxes*
- *Motor oil, antifreeze, paint thinner, solvent, pesticide or hazardous materials containers*

## Cardboard - Large Bin

Corrugated cardboard and brown paper bags.

Remove all packing materials. Paper packing material can be recycled as mixed waste paper or newspaper if it is newsprint. Flatten and stack neatly in the cardboard bin.



*No Styrofoam, plastic packing or wax-coated boxes.*
